For some students, playing games after completing homework can also act as a stress reliever.
3. However, online games also have certain disadvantages. Playing for long hours can reduce the time available for studies, outdoor activities, and family interaction. Excessive screen time may cause headaches, eye strain, and poor posture. Competitive games like Free Fire may sometimes make students short-tempered or disappointed when they lose, which can affect their behaviour. In extreme cases, children may become addicted to gaming and find it difficult to stop playing.
4. Therefore, it is important for students to maintain a healthy balance. Parents and teachers should guide children to set time limits and choose age-appropriate games. Students should learn that games are meant for enjoyment and learning, not as a replacement for studies or real-life activities. When played responsibly, online games can be both enjoyable and beneficial.

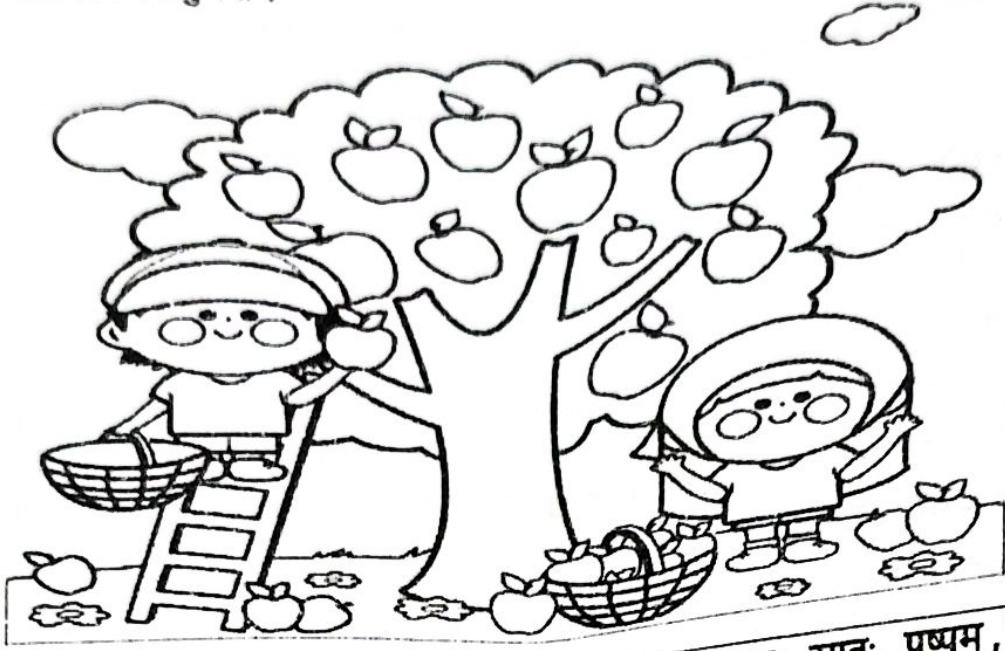

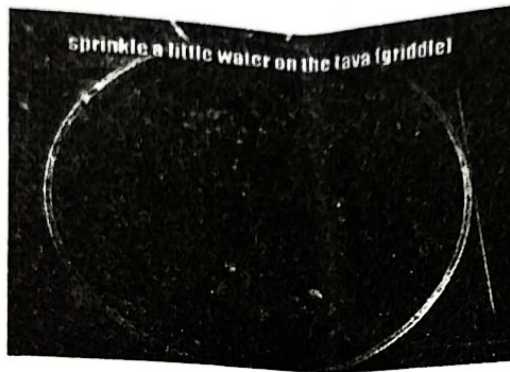
